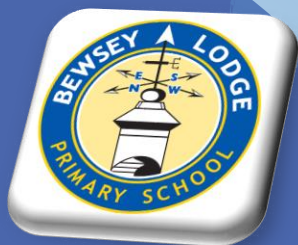

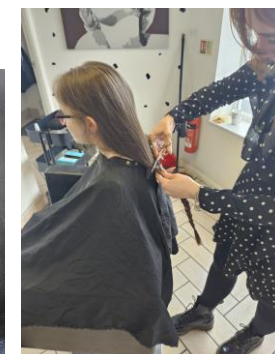
Crazy Hair To Show We Care!
