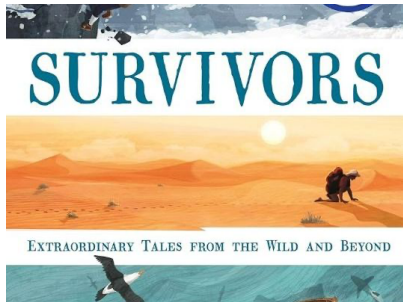


Emerald - Survivors!
