Include what it likes to eat, where it lives and a picture of what it looks like.</p>	<p>Design a new sea creature and describe it!</p>
<p>Draw and label the 5 oceans. Create a simple world map and label the 5 oceans.</p>	<p>Plastic pollution investigation. Find out why plastic is harmful to ocean animals. Write 2-3 sentences and draw a picture to explain.</p>	<p>Write 5 "wow" facts about the ocean.</p>
<p>Make an ocean model. Create an ocean scene using a shoebox, Lego or craft materials. Include some sea creatures.</p>	<p>Create a poster showing how we can protect the oceans. Include at least 3 ideas (e.g., don't drop litter, recycle).</p>	<p>A day as an ocean explorer - write 3 - 5 sentences about your day exploring the ocean. What did you see? How did you feel?</p>
