Find out 3 facts about the Stone Age. Use a book, video, or website with an adult.	Draw a Stone Age shelter. Label the different parts.	Write 3 sentences about Stone Age life. Think about food, shelter and tools.
Find out what people ate in the Stone Age. Draw or list 3 examples.	Design a Bronze Age roundhouse. Draw it and label the roof, walls and fire pit.	Draw a picture of a Stone Age person. Label their clothes and items they carry.
Draw a timeline. Can you label the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age?	Make your own cave painting. Use chalk, paint, or mud colours on paper or card.	Write 3 questions you'd like to ask an Iron Age person. Think about how their life would have been different from yours.
Find out 3 facts about Iron Age people. For example, tools, farming, homes or hillforts.	Build a model of an Iron Age hillfort. Use Lego, blocks or junk modelling. Get your grown up to take pictures.	Draw a picture of an Iron Age person. Label their clothes, tools and home.
