Make a list of at least 10 onomatopoeic words that could be used in a superhero story.</p>	<p>Design a Villain. Draw a supervillain and write a sentence describing their powers and personality.</p>
<p>Superpower Wishlist. If you could have one superpower, what would it be and why? Write a short paragraph.</p>	<p>Comic Strip Creator. Create a short comic strip with at least 4 boxes showing a problem and a solution.</p>	<p>Action Adverbs. Write a list of exciting adverbs that could be used in a superhero chase scene.</p>
<p>Build a Super Suit. Design a superhero costume and label its special features, what does it help your superhero do?</p>	<p>Design a Superhero Lair. Draw and label a superhero's secret lair.
