Can you write your age and your house number too?</p>	<p>Research Boudicca.</p> <p>Write a short fact file about Boudicca and the Iceni tribe. Include at least three interesting facts.</p>	<p>Roman Bathhouse Drawing.</p> <p>Draw and label the different rooms in a Roman bathhouse.</p>
<p>Roman Soldier Training.</p> <p>Find out how Roman soldiers trained. Write or draw three things they had to do to become strong soldiers.</p>	<p>Centurion Fact File.</p> <p>Create a fact file about a Roman centurion. Find out what their job was, what they wore and how they led their soldiers. Include at least three interesting facts and a labelled picture.</p>	<p>Create a Roman Mosaic.</p> <p>Design your own Roman mosaic pattern using coloured paper, felt tips or small squares. Roman mosaics were often used to decorate floors in villas and bathhouses.</p>
