



KEY VOCABULARY

- **Narrative** - a story with characters and events.
- **Character** - a person or creature in a story.
- **Setting** - where and when a story takes place.
- **Paragraph** - a group of sentences about one idea.
- **Problem** - something that goes wrong in the story.
- **Resolution** - how the problem is solved.
- **Adverb** - a word that tells us how, when or where something happens.
- **Preposition** - a word that shows position or direction.
- **Simile** - a comparison using *like* or *as*.
- **Superhero** - a brave character with special abilities who helps others.
- **Villain** - a character who causes trouble or danger.
