I can place the time studied on a timeline.			
I understand that a timeline can be split into BC and AD			
I can use and understand appropriate historical vocabulary to communicate information such as ruled, empire, emperor, invasion and conquer.			
I can answer and sometimes devise my own questions to find answers about the past.

I can gather more detail from sources (such as maps or observing small details in artefacts or pictures) to build a clearer picture of the past.			
I can begin to undertake my own research by selecting and recording information relevant to the topic, using a range of sources including the internet.			
I am beginning to understand that some sources are more reliable than others e.g website, fake artefacts, different perspectives etc...			
I can make comparisons between periods in history and today relating to aspects of everyday life e.g. homes, clothes, food, pastimes, survival, farming and work/service (lighthouses).			
I understand the changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, including Neolithic Hunter-gatherers and early farmers.			
I understand the significance of tool making in the Stone Age.			
I understand the significance and importance of cave paintings.			
I understand how Stone Age man had to adapt to survive.			
I understand the main differences between the stone, Iron and Bronze ages.			
I can describe the spread of the Roman empire and recall key facts about the invasion of Britain.			
I am beginning to compare accounts of events from different sources and offer some reasons for different versions of events (Boudica and Viking raids).			
I can describe the impact of technology, culture and beliefs on Britain as a			

result of "Romanisation".			
I know why the Vikings and Anglo Saxons left their homeland and settled in Britain.			
I can describe what life was like for Anglo Saxons and Vikings.
