<u>Geography</u> Explain why the River Nile was so important to the Ancient Egyptians.	<u>Maths</u> Go on a number hunt! Find numbers to 1,000 on signs, houses or vehicles. Record your findings.	<u>Handwriting</u> Copy your two favourite Egyptian facts in your neatest handwriting.	<u>Creative</u> Build a pyramid using LEGO or recycled materials.
