

## Behaviour and Safety

Little Links Club is an environment which is more relaxed than school however, we expect the same high standards of behaviour as we do during the normal school day.

Staff will use a range of strategies to encourage children to make the right behaviour choices. Should poor behaviour arise, staff again employ a range of strategies to encourage children to self-reflect and turn behaviour around.

Parents and carers will always be informed of any issues around behaviour and will be invited to work with staff in resolving them. In the event of persistent poor behaviour, where staff have exhausted all appropriate strategies, a child's place maybe withdrawn. In the event of behaviour seriously endangering the safety of an adult or child immediate suspension would apply.

Strong links with parents/carers is welcomed at our club which is why we have a number of ways in which you can communicate with the team.

Linking parents to school, the club provides before and after school care for children. We can tailor sessions to best meet your needs and offer a range of pricing options and discounts.

**Little Links Club** is based within our main school building and caters for children aged 3-11 years old. The sessions offer a range of activities which engage children and create opportunities for them to socialise, to have fun and make new friends from different classes and year groups. Indoor activities include crafts, junk modelling, lego, painting, drawing and colouring, free play, board games, keep-fit, puzzle-time, reading area, playing with a wide range of toys, dressing-up and occasional film nights.

All staff are employed by the school. They are all DBS checked, they are all fully trained in the safeguarding of children and have relevant food hygiene and first aid training. Outdoor activities include organised team games, mini bikes, dodgeball, large garden games, free play on the field, free play with PE equipment such as bats, balls, hoola-hoops, skipping ropes, quoits and beanbags, use of large school play equipment and occasional forest school sessions. Children also have the opportunity to complete homework and reading with the support of the Little Links staff.

After 4.15pm, children are offered a light snack for example: croissant with a choice of filling, brioche, pancakes with toppings, crumpets and toast. Drinks and fresh fruit are always available.

Fees are payable in advance and booking, whilst not always necessary, is advisable. Where families request full time places, they will be charged full price for the 1st child and offered a 10% discount for subsequent siblings who take a full time place.
