CONSULTATION ON PROPOSED ACADEMY CONVERSION

We are writing to inform you that the Governing Board of Bewsey Lodge Primary School has taken the decision to apply for academy status and join the newly formed Emmanuel Diocese of Liverpool Academies Trust.

This multi-academy trust is being formed with local Warrington schools, both Church of England and community schools, that have worked collaboratively for many years together in school improvement and to create opportunities for our pupils.

This decision has been taken following discussions by school leaders and their Governing Boards, with representatives from the Liverpool Diocesan Board of Education, and with the other schools who are looking to join the newly formed MAT. We believe this would benefit our pupils and staff enormously.

The Rational

The educational landscape within Warrington continues to change with an increasing number of primary schools joining multi-academy trusts. The Governing Board at Bewsey Lodge Primary School believes that the best future for the school is to become an academy and join Emmanuel Diocese of Liverpool Academies Trust (EDLAT). Joining the Trust at the formation stage will be a positive step for the school and enable it to be a key stakeholder in decision-making.
