The day was packed with hands-on activities including canoeing, river dipping, and orienteering. Canoeing offered a unique view of the river and helped the children observe features such as flow, banks, and human impact. River dipping was a particular highlight, as the children discovered and identified various freshwater creatures, linking their learning to both geography and science. Orienteering encouraged teamwork and developed their map-reading and navigation skills. Experiencing the River Mersey first-hand helped bring classroom learning to life, deepening the children's understanding of rivers, habitats, and the environment. The trip also promoted resilience, cooperation, and a real sense of adventure. The children returned full of enthusiasm and new knowledge after a brilliant day outdoors!
