If seen riding, you will be asked by a member of staff to adhere to this important rule immediately – failure to do so may result in a playground ban or a ban on bringing your equipment onto school grounds. Please help us to keep everyone safe and happy in our school – thank you.

We have also been told this week about a family of children who are playing on the side road which leads up to the carpark. We have sent a letter to the family to explain that the road is used daily by school traffic and pointed out the dangers however, I just wanted to draw your attention to this issue also. If you have permission to access the side road please be vigilant, the children are very young and small so I would ask you to drive with extreme caution and do extra checks when making any manoeuvre – thank you.






