In other news, the Governors and I would like to inform you of a slight change to our Nursery Provision. We are currently classed as a maintained Nursery which means the provision falls under the umbrella of the main school and is maintained by the local authority. After some careful consideration, we have made the decision to convert to a Governor-led Nursery. The main difference between the two is that in a Governor led Nursery, you have the option to appoint a lead adult for the room who is not necessarily a teacher (as with a private nursery). Our Nursery will continue to run in exactly the same way, expectations will remain high and the setting will still function under the rigorous systems and procedures we have in place for health, safety and safeguarding in the rest of the school. A Governor working group is in place to ensure a smooth transition and to ensure that standards in all areas remain high as usual. There are no plans to make any staffing changes this academic year but if you have any questions about this change, please contact us in the usual ways.
