For Rosa's birthday, we are having a "design a t-shirt" competition. From the class winners, Rosa House Captains will choose 1 overall winner and also select a handful of winners from the paper designs. There will be little prizes for everyone who designs a t-shirt on the day and masses of house points to win!
