Some important messages

School start time:

Doors open at 8.45am

Speech & Language Training

On Wednesday 15th November at 3:30pm until 5pm, we would like to invite parents/carers to join us, in school, for some speech and language training. The training will be delivered by a speech and language therapist and will look at ways to support **reluctant speakers**. If you would like to join us, please contact the school office. Important Roles In School

As you know we have houses at school – Malala (yellow), Rosa (green), Attenborough (blue) and Elton (red). Each year we need to enroll new House Captains but this year it's a bit different. Usually we have a House Leader (an adult in school) and then 2 Vice Captains from year 6. This year we will be having The House Leader and the House Captains from year 6 and then Vice Captains from year 5. The year 5 children will then become the House Captain next year.

Children who want to take on these roles have to make a short video presentation explaining why they would do a good job. The videos are then played to each class and the children cast their votes. The successful candidates, who will also be the School Council Representatives, will be revealed in next Friday's end of half term assembly and will be given a tie in the colour of their house – exciting!

We are also taking applications for Subject Champions. Each subject has a handful of Champions which help the subject leader run it in school. In this role, children come up with ideas on how to make the subject exciting, how to showcase the best talents in school and they also look through workbooks to get an understanding about how the subject is taught and why across school. Again, the names will be revealed in next week's assembly.

In next week's assembly I will also be introducing playground PALS, another important role in school. These children, who will need to apply for the role, will be responsible for organising games on the 3 playgrounds at lunchtimes 3 times a week. They will also be the team who are there for children on the playground if someone needs a friend or someone to talk to. I'll tell you more about this brand new group after the half term.

I am really looking forward to seeing who our successful candidates are for these important roles in school.


