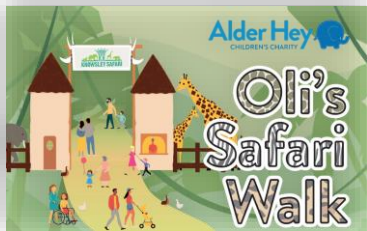

### Oli's Safari Walk



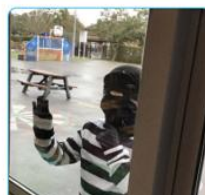
