Well done Opal who are top of the league for Key Stage 2 with 97.8% and Silver Class with 96.9% for Early Years and Key Stage 1. Enjoy your extra play time. Please be aware that if your child's attendance falls below 90% it means that they are a 'persistent absentee'. This 90% threshold is linked to poor academic achievement and a higher risk of poor mental health. Remember, when in school, children learn, play, make friends, and discover new things every day.
