TALK, SHARE, PLAY

Take turns communicating

Attention: remove distraction such as turn off the TV
put away your phone

Listen and respond to how your child communicates

Keep language simple

Sit with your child so you can see each other's faces

Help them turn the pages

Attend to their requests

Repeat what they communicate and copy what they do

Enjoy a book - talk about the pictures or what your
child is most interested in

Pretend - use everyday objects like cups, spoons,
brushes and role play eg going shopping

Love and support - you are the best play partner!
